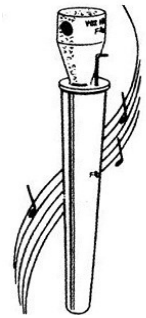
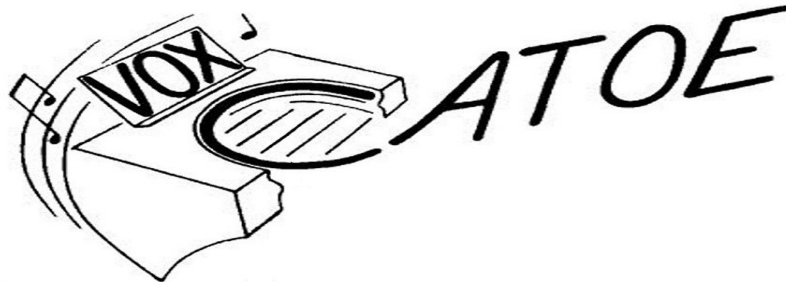

The Tivoli Theatre located at: **5021 Highland Ave. Downers Grove, IL 60515 Phone: 630-968-0219**. It is one block east of Main Street on Highland Avenue. Main street is Lemont Road when coming from the south suburbs, and is eas-

ily reached from I-55 (Stevenson) on the south, Ogden Avenue on the north, and east of Route 53 and the I-355 North/South Toll.

CATOE is very lucky in that most of the theatre organs that we maintain are used on a regular basis. Our own 3/10 in the Tivoli is used for both evening shows on Friday and Saturday evenings and also for special events. The 2/7 Baby Barton in the York Theatre is also used for several events during the month. On the second Tuesday of each month, the 3/17 Geneva/Marr Colton in the Arcada is used to accompany a silent film classic. The 3/10 Wurlitzer in Downers Grove North High School plays before all of the fall, winter and spring musical events held in the auditorium. The Pickwick and Mundelein are also used for special events.

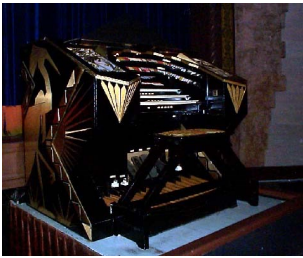
I could use someone to take over the CATOE social setup and take down for a while (at least until 2021). Need to tote the supplies, setup the tables and clean up after we are done.
