Silent movies continue at the Arcada in St. Charles. Please take an opportunity to attend as this shows our support for the theatre.

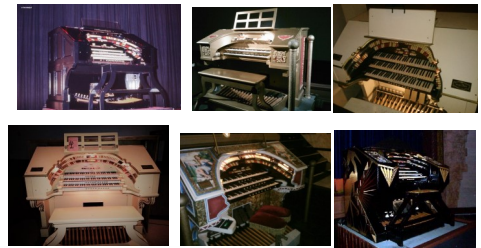
September 10 will be Buster Keaton in "Three Ages".
